Often called "The Workers' Bible", "The Ragged Trousered Philanthropists" has been one of the most influential books of modern times. It was often said that the book won Labour the 1946 General Election, when a stunned Tory party saw Winston Churchill defeated at the polls. The book is one of the first realistic fictional portrayals of life amongst the working classes, brilliantly analysing the power structures that keep the status quo stable, even when people are clearly ill treated and abused.

This adaptation honours the original, while tailoring the action for a modern audience – for how much has changed? Tressell wrote about a time of boom and bust; of high unemployment; of a slump in the building trade; of graft, sleaze and downright thieving amongst politicians and the wealthy. Sound familiar?
